




Happy Bottle How-Tos

Complementary to Pt. II Video

How to add a label:

 **Step 1:** Peel label from sheet. Delicately place the label on your preferred spot on the happy bottle, so lightly that the edges do not touch yet, only the middle of the label sticks slightly to the bottle.

 **Step 2:** Smooth the label from the middle out, using the center as a pivot point so that there should be no bubbles.

 **Step 3:** If you bought waterproof labels, there is a bit more “wiggle room.” If not, you can still lightly peel up if need be.

If you have bubbles: Light adjustments are possible, but be very careful, especially if the labels are not waterproof. You can best remove the bubbles by rubbing in a circular motion toward the edge of the label.

If you have to remove it completely and try again: Make sure you wipe any sticky material or dust before replacing the label as this may cause more bubbles.

No time:

Adding a label over the original: Do the same as adding a label to a naked bottle, but make sure it is lined evenly over the original label so nothing shows. Be very careful, as it can be impossible to remove the new label and try again when there is another underneath.

Tag + Straw: You can purchase our gift tags and some paper straws (craft stores have them for no more than a few \$!) then tie them with ribbon to the top of your happy bottle for an easy no-label-involved method.
